



2020 ACAP SCHOLARSHIPS CRITERIA (Graduating Seniors Only)

ACAP Scholarships are available to those Graduating Seniors only who have applied to the 2020 Dallas and TCU ACAPs by the April 30, 2020 deadline date. These Graduating Seniors must also apply for the ACAP Scholarship by the May 31, 2020 scholarship deadline date and must meet the requirements outlined below. Total scholarship dollars awarded depend on funding (generally in increments of \$500, \$750, or \$1,000). The scholarships will be awarded on June 23, 2020. The funds will be disbursed in late August or early September upon proof of enrollment in college.

Eligibility:

Candidates for a scholarship must meet the following eligibility criteria:

- High school student who has applied to 2020 Dallas or TCU ACAP by the April 30, 2020 deadline date
- Completed the online 2020 ACAP Scholarship Application (see <https://www.surveymonkey.com/r/6MWSBNV>) by the May 31, 2020 deadline date.
- A Graduating Senior of a high school with a GPA of 3.0 or better
- Has applied to one or more accredited colleges/universities for Fall 2020 as a full-time undergraduate student with an intended major in accounting, finance, or business
- Have access to the Internet and computer to attend any online required meeting and training, or complete the required pre-work established by ACAP Leadership
- Submit to an interview as scheduled by ACAP Leadership

- A 500-word essay as part of the Scholarship Application to include:
 - NABA's motto is "**Lifting As We Climb**": What does this mean to you and what do you envision doing to perpetuate it in the future?
 - Any additional information on you which may assist the Scholarship Selection Committee (e.g., resume, etc.)
- Assigned work as per the College Readiness Workshop
- A headshot photo

Selection Criteria:

The selection is based on the following criteria:

- Character, leadership and service (20 points)
- Meeting eligibility requirements (15 points)
- 500-word essay (content and quality, 30 points)
- Overall application quality (20 points)
- Interview (15 points)
