



2021 ACAP SCHOLARSHIPS

GENERAL INFORMATION:

Some of the questions for the scholarship interview and consideration of the student for ACAP scholarships will be based on information the student included in the ACAP Application and/or information included in the supporting documents. Thus, the interviewer should review the submitted documents prior to the ACAP interview and ask those questions that will assist him/her in completing the grading rubric.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

Applicants for an ACAP Scholarship must meet the following eligibility requirements:

- A graduating senior currently enrolled in ACAP 2021.
- Submitted all required supporting documents for admission into ACAP 2021:
 - ACAP application
 - Student Interest Form
 - Two (2) Letters of Recommendation
 - Unofficial High School Transcript
- Plan to enroll in a college or university as a full-time undergraduate student in Fall 2021 with an intended major in accounting, finance, or business.

ADDITIONAL SCHOLARSHIP PACKAGE REQUIREMENTS:

As part of the scholarship requirements, the Scholarship Applicant must:

- Submit a 500—word essay addressing **ONE** of the following topics:
 - Topic 1: What does ***“Lifting as We Climb”*** mean to you?
 - Topic 2: How do you plan to use your professional career objective(s) to impact your community?
- Show evidence of satisfactory completion of the required ACAP assignments (body of work per curriculum).
- Provide additional information which may assist the Scholarship Selection Committee (optional).

DISBURSEMENT CRITERIA:

Prior to the scholarship funds being disbursed, the Scholarship Recipient must:

- Provide proof of enrollment in a college or university for Fall 2021.
- Provide a “Thank You” letter to the scholarship sponsor.
- Provide proof of enrollment in NABA either as a member of a Student Chapter or as a NABA Student Member At-Large.

AWARDS :

The scholarship amount will be determined by the funds allocated for disbursement by the ACAP Chapter Administrators, the academic credentials of the applicant, and the recipient’s placement in relation to other scholarship winners. Awards will be announced during ACAP; however, the actual disbursement of the funds will not be made until late August or September 2021 after the disbursement criteria has been met.
