



Accounting Career Awareness Program ACAP Scholarship Frequently Asked Questions

How are applicants selected to receive the ACAP Scholarships?

All ACAP Scholarship Applications will be reviewed by the ACAP Scholarship Selections Committee. Scores will be based on neatness of quality of application, composition of essay, grade point average, extracurricular activities, and points earned during ACAP Week, as reflected in the Grading Sheet. High scores from the initial process will be invited for an interview with the ACAP Scholarship Selections Committee. The combined application scores, ACAP Week points, and interview will determine ACAP scholarship recipients.

What will happen during the interviews?

The selected ACAP Scholarship Recipient will meet individually or with a small panel and will be asked a series of thought-provoking questions regarding goals, objectives, and views.

How will I be notified if I am selected as an ACAP Scholarship Recipient?

All selected ACAP Scholarship Recipients will be notified by the ACAP Executive Director. After notification, ACAP will award the scholarship at the ACAP Closing Banquet.

When will monetary awards be provided?

Monetary awards will be mailed to recipient in September once official proof of enrollment is received from the recipient/school. If you are planning to use the award towards tuition for the upcoming semester, please be advised that it can take up to 2-3 weeks to receive the award once proof of enrollment is received from you. It is important for you to make plans around tuition accordingly.

What is proof of enrollment?

Every ACAP Scholarship Recipient is required to show proof that they will be matriculating as a full-time student. Proof of enrollment can take the form of a letter from the Registrar or actual receipt. Please note that depending on the institution, the "Official" registration is generally not available until after the last drop date.

Are ACAP scholarship awards made payable to the student or to the school?

Awards are made payable to the scholarship recipient unless otherwise requested. Awardees will complete a Student Information Form which should be used to indicate where the check should be mailed.
