#### **National ACAP Overview**

- ACAP: The flagship high school student program under the umbrella of the National Association of Black Accountants, Inc. (NABA).
- Goal and Objective: To attract ethnic minority students to accounting, finance, and other related fields once they matriculate to college and choose a major.
- Weeklong residency program held at a college or university.
- ACAP started in the Seattle area in 1984.



#### **Dallas ACAP Overview**

- Started in the Dallas/Fort Worth area in 2001 (SMU).
- Starts an inaugural program at TCU in July 2021.





Obtain a basic understanding of career paths in accounting and finance.

Demonstrate a fundamental understanding of the importance of a high grade point average.

Obtain an understanding of the college admissions process.

Obtain an understanding of the college financing process.

Understand and embrace effective study skills.

Create a thoughtful, actionable, college and career plan.



### Dallas ACAP Accomplishments

#### **Consistency in Leadership**

- Maintained consistent and dedicated leadership since inception in 2001 (20 years).
- Existed on the campus of SMU for 17 years.

#### **ACAP Alums**

Almost 900 students have graduated from the program since inception in 2001.

#### **Awarded Scholarship Dollars**

- Graduated almost 900 students from the program since inception in 2001.
- Awarded \$3,000 \$5,000 in scholarship dollars annually.
- Tracking of Scholarship Recipients for the last five (5) years:
  - Awarded \$59,000 in scholarship dollars
  - 100% of scholarship recipients attended college
  - 83% of those who attended college majored in business
  - 52% of those who attended college majored in Accounting
  - 17% of those who attended college intend to become CPAs
- Was awarded the Nora O'Garro/Odell Brown Scholarship at SMU (\$10,000 to each ACAP alum that enrolls in SMU's Master's of Science in Accounting Program, <a href="https://www.smu.edu/cox/At-SMU-Cox/Cox-News/SMU-Cox-ACAP-Scholarship">https://www.smu.edu/cox/At-SMU-Cox/Cox-News/SMU-Cox-ACAP-Scholarship</a>).
